- ❖ Your local pharmacy may offer some immunizations and take your insurance. Contact them directly for details.

Immunizations required for school attendance include the following: *IPV* (Polio), *DTaP* (Diphtheria, Tetanus, acellular Pertussis), *DT* (Diphtheria, Tetanus), *Td* (Tetanus, diphtheria), *Tdap* (Tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis), *HEP B* (Hepatitis B), *MMR* (Measles, Mumps, Rubella), and *VARICELLA* (Chickenpox).

For preschool only: *Hib* (Hemophilus Influenza B) and *PCV* (Pneumococcal conjugate)

Other immunizations that children may receive but are not required for school attendance include *Hepatitis A, Meningococcal, Influenza, HPV (Human papillomavirus)*, and *Rotavirus (for infants only)*.

Immunizations are provided for children through the age of 18 years.

Remember to bring your child's immunization record with you to the clinic.
