I am very appreciative of their support and deeply grateful for the opportunity to work with them.

I offer a parting thought to the broad community. As we consider the fall, I think of it as a recovery time, when we get to work with our students in-person five days per week. I also think of it as a renaissance. In my mind, it is a time to leave the dark period behind and find joy in what we can do for our young people who have sacrificed so much. It is a time for creativity, innovation, and an openness to fresh starts.

In closing, thank you for the friendship. Peninsula will always remain as a part of my family. In the words of an old Irish blessing, "May the dreams you hold dearest be those that come true; may the kindness you spread keep returning to you."

Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) College Readiness Program Celebrates Seniors



Peninsula High School's third annual AVID College Signing Day and Senior Celebration on Monday, June 7 honored 20 PHS seniors who formally announced their post high school decisions in front of an audience of school staff and peers.

The AVID program is designed to help students develop the skills they need to be successful in college. AVID places special emphasis on growing writing, critical thinking, teamwork, organization, and reading skills. During the event, each student was called upon to announce their post-high school plans and receive their AVID honor cord to wear at graduation. Then, as a group, they signed college and postgraduate letters of intent. The event culminated the hard work AVID students have put in over the last four years to ready themselves for success beyond high school. They collectively earned over \$32,000 at PHS's Senior Scholarship Night. Some students received additional money in other scholarships and grants from their respective schools, scholarships, and the College Bound Program.

"As mostly first generation college students, our AVID students overcame obstacles to achieve success," said AVID Site Coordinator, Kim Demianiw. "These students learned to think critically, collaborate, and set high expectations to confidently conquer the challenges that await them. We are very proud of their achievements."

27 High School Students Earn Varsity Letters in Community Service

Since 2017, Peninsula School District has honored high school students who volunteer their time and talents to uplift others in our community and region with varsity letters in community service.

This year, 27 high school students from across the district earned a varsity letter in community service. To receive a letter, students completed 100 or more hours of community service, maintained at least a 2.0 GPA, and completed the application process.

Overall, 3,892.8 total hours of community service were completed by the varsity

letter recipients. Some organizations where service hours were provided include Food Backpacks 4 Kids, FISH Food Bank, PenMet Parks, local churches, school clubs, and many more.



School Construction Projects Ahead of Schedule

On February 12, 2019, the PSD community passed a \$198.55 million bond for school construction to address extreme elementary overcrowding and other emergent infrastructure needs.

The projects identified in the bond included the replacement of Artondale and Evergreen elementary schools, construction of Swift Water Elementary located on Harbor Hill Drive across from the YMCA, and construction of Pioneer Elementary located on Skansie Avenue. After elementary overcrowding and emergent facility needs, addressing middle school overcrowding was identified as the district's next highest priority.

Due to cost-saving steps made by the district, additional state assistance received for Swift Water Elementary, and an accelerated construction schedule for our elementary projects, we are now able to modernize and add additional classrooms at Kopachuck Middle School and Key Peninsula Middle School using 2019 capital bond funds.

Middle School Modernization Construction Begins in Summer 2021

Because of cost-saving steps made by the district, we are able to modernize and add additional classrooms at Kopachuck Middle School and Key Peninsula Middle School using 2019 capital bond funds.

After elementary overcrowding and emergent facility needs, addressing middle school overcrowding was identified as the district's next highest priority.

Construction bids for both middle school projects were opened and the contracts were awarded in June. At the June 10, 2021 study session, the PSD Board of Directors awarded the bid for Kopachuck Middle School to Schwiesow Construction. At the June 24, 2021 business meeting, the PSD Board of Directors awarded the bid for Key Peninsula Middle School to Kassel & Associates.

Construction for both modernization and addition projects is scheduled to begin in July, with phased construction and a completion in the spring of 2023.

Three Elementary Schools Opening This Fall

Here are some of the latest updates on PSD's elementary school construction sites, funded by the voter-approved 2019 capital bond. Pioneer Elementary opened in January 2021, and the three elementary schools below are scheduled to open during fall 2021.

Artondale Elementary School Replacement and Expansion

Bond-Approved Opening: Fall 2021 Projected Opening: Fall 2021

A new building is being constructed on the school's existing upper playfield, allowing students and staff to remain in the old school until the new building opens. After the new school is opened, the old building will be demolished and the new playfield will be constructed.





Evergreen Elementary School Replacement and Expansion

Bond-Approved Opening: Fall 2022 Projected Opening: Fall 2021

A new school is being constructed adjacent to the existing school. After construction is complete, the old building will be demolished. The existing gym will remain for district and community use.

Swift Water Elementary New School

Bond-Approved Opening: Fall 2021 Projected Opening: Fall 2021

Swift Water Elementary is a new school located on Harbor Hill Drive across from the YMCA. The district purchased this parcel of land in 2013 in anticipation of the increased number of students residing in the growing Gig Harbor North area.

Cuperintendent Krestin Bahr, who **O**officially started with Peninsula School District on July 1, is responsible for fulfilling the mission of our district and schools and improving learning for all children. This role provides essential leadership to hire and develop quality staff, secure and manage funds and

- Identify the district's strengths, improvement opportunities, and challenges.

This plan has three phases:

- Student, staff, and community engagement (July 1 - December 31, 2021); and
- Summary report and strategic plan updates and recommendations (fall 2021 - winter 2022).
